

Background Checks Policy- All new AYS Board members, commissioners, and head coaches are required to complete a background check. This check must be conducted prior to their participation in the AYS program and will be done yearly if individual is continuously active in the AYS program. Background checks are considered confidential and will only be discussed within the AYS Board of Directors, when determining individual's eligibility. Once the background check is complete, the AYS Background Check Appeals Committee head chairman will review results. If no record is found, AYS will not notify you. If background check discloses any convictions for a felony or misdemeanor, the committee will discuss actions and report back to the AYS Board of Directors, in which AYS has all rights to suspend individual from all AYS duties. If an active individual subsequently has any criminal charges brought against him/her, they are required to immediately disclose the nature of the charges to the AYS Board of Directors and voluntarily terminate all their duties until a determination is made by the board regarding the effect the pending charges has on his/her duties within the program.
